### These are the major Nursing Related Databases:

**Academic Search Complete** Multi-disciplinary database with more than 5,500 full-text periodicals.

**ACS Web Editions** Peer reviewed Chemistry Journals covering chemistry and related sciences, published by the American Chemical Society.

**BioOne** Peer-reviewed research journals in the areas of Biology, Ecology and Environmental Sciences.

**CINAHL with Full Text** The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature covers nursing, biomedicine, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer, and allied health. Includes journals, books, nursing dissertations, conference Proceedings, standards of practice, evidence-based care sheets, educational software, and audiovisuals.

**Cochrane Library** Databases presenting research on the effectiveness of healthcare treatments and interventions. Presents independent evidence-based reviews of treatment studies, methods,

clinical trials, technology assessments and economic evaluations to inform decisions on health care.

**EBSCO eBooks** online books covering many subject areas including nursing and health sciences.

**Health Reference Center Academic** Provides citations and some full text and images of respected nursing, allied health and medical journals, consumer health magazines, newsletters, pamphlets, newspaper articles, topical overviews, and medical reference books. Remote access with University Network account.

**Health Source:** Nursing/Academic Information on many health topics including the medical sciences, food sciences and nutrition, childcare, sports medicine and general health. Remote access with University Network account.

**MasterFILE** Multidisciplinary database provides full text for more than 1,750 general reference publications with full text information dating as far back as 1975.

**MedicLatina** Spanish language collection of medical research and investigative journals published by renowned Latin American medical publishers. Offers full text for nearly 100 peer-reviewed medical journals in native Spanish. Remote access with University Network account.

**MEDLINE with MeSH** The National Library of Medicine's database providing citations and abstracts to authoritative information on medicine, nursing, dentistry, veterinary medicine, the health care system, pre-clinical sciences, and more. Some links to full text. Remote access with University Network account.

**National Institutes of Health** Primary Federal agency for conducting and supporting medical research offers links to 27 Institutes and Centers such as the National Cancer Institute, National Institute on Aging, National Human Genome Research Institute, National Institute on Drug Abuse, National Institute of Nursing Research, and the National Library of Medicine. Free web access.

**Natural & Alternative Treatments** A complementary and alternative medicine database designed specifically for the consumer health researcher. Updated weekly, this database provides current information that will satisfy an ever-growing demand for accurate, unbiased information on natural health.

**Nursing Books@Ovid** ProQuest's Full text electronic books from Lippencott/Springhouse that include authoritative content on nursing interventions, procedures, and techniques. Contains manuals of care plans, lab and diagnostic tests, nursing practice, complementary therapies, and current drug guides.

**Proquest Nursing & Allied Health Resource** Covers nursing, allied health, alternative and complementary medicine. Includes scholarly journal articles, dissertations, e-book content, evidence based research, systemic reviews of healthcare treatments, multicultural resources, and training videos.

**PubMed Central** Provides text based searching for citations to biomedical literature, including citations from MEDLINE. Some links to full text in free online journals or publisher websites. Free web access.

**PubMed Tutorial** Web-based learning program that will show you how to search PubMed®, the National Library of Medicine (NLM®) journal literature search system.

**TOXNET** Toxicology data network from the National Library of Medicine.
